Shorts

(Seasonal, August-October 1; May 1-End of School Year)



- Style: Loose-fitting, bermuda-length (10" to 12" inseam) or longer, dress/formal style. No denim or denim-like material.
- Color: Solid navy, khaki beige, gray, or black

Where to Find Shorts

- Search: bermuda length, 10" or 11" or 12" inseam, chino shorts
- JCPenney, Walmart, Lands' End, Kohl's, The Children's Place, French Toast, etc.
- Note: Online stores offer more selection

Acceptable Shorts for Dress Down Days

- Bermuda length or longer
- Must cover most of the thigh and fit loosely
- Denim is allowed
- Not allowed: Athletic shorts; sweatpant-material





Violations of the ICS Dress Code

- Tears, rips, or holes
- Leggings or spandex worn as shorts or pants; bike shorts
- Too short of a length (less than a 9" inseam)
- Too-tight or too-loose of a fit (Shorts must be worn in an appropriate manner, not baggy or below the waist.)

Parents of students in violation of the ICS Dress Code will be called and will need to bring approved clothing for their student to change into at school.
